Driven by the ECOWAS Commission and implemented by the International Organization for Migration, the International Centre for Migration Policy Development and the International Labour Organization, FMM West Africa offers technical assistance and capacity building in the management of issues relating to migration.

The project, which is funded by the European Union and the ECOWAS Commission, has a budget of over € 26 million and a five-year timeline to support West Africa at regional, national and local level.
