

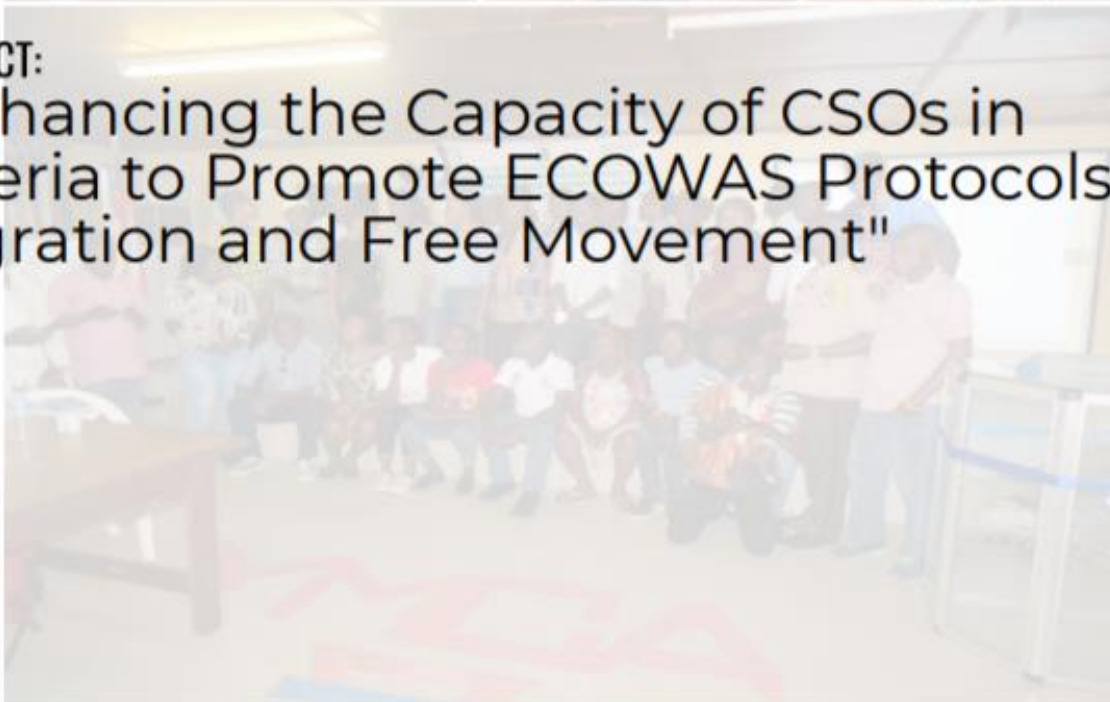

## Project Grant Signing

The grant signing took place on at the IOM Liberia Country Office.



## CSO Mapping Survey Validation Meeting

A mapping survey was conducted to identify CSOs and other non-state actors engaged in free movement, migration and combatting TiP and child labour and the validation of the mapping report was conducted on 22 July 2019.



## Training Workshops for CSO Platform Members on Free Movement and Migration management, TiP and Irregular Migration

To strengthen the capacities of the members of the *CSO Platform to Promote ECOWAS Protocols on Free Movement and Combat Human Trafficking in Liberia*, the members were trained on the ECOWAS Protocols of Free Movement and Migration, TiP and irregular migration and CSO platform management and sustainability.

### Training Workshop on CSO Platform Management and Sustainability

The training workshop took place from 5 -7 February 2020. 30 platform members were trained.



### Training Workshop on TiP and Irregular Migration

The training workshop took place from 12 – 14 February 2020 and 30 platform members were trained.



### Training Workshop on ECOWAS Protocols of Free Movement and Migration

The training workshop took place from 17 -19 February 2020 and 30 platform members were trained.



### Sensitization Training Workshop for Media Practitioners on the ECOWAS Protocols of Free Movement

To increase the awareness and understanding of the ECOWAS Protocols of Free Movement, NACCSOL organized a workshop for media practitioners from 13 – 14 February 2020 and 50 media practitioners were

trained. The workshop was part of NACCSOL’s sensitization and awareness-raising activities that took place from 13 – 28 February 2020



### Training Workshop for Law Enforcement on the ECOWAS Protocols of Free Movement

To increase the awareness and understanding of the ECOWAS Protocols of Free Movement, NACCSOL organized a workshop for law enforcement personnel from 24 – 26 February 2020 and 30 law enforcement personnel were trained. The training curriculum used in the training for law enforcement was developed by NACCSOL.





## National Roundtable on Issues of Internal, Regional and International Migration

A one-day National Roundtable was organized by NACCSOL and its collaborating partners and was held at Corina Hotel in Monrovia on 26 February 2020. 69 stakeholders participated in the roundtable.
